Background Information and Rationale:

The Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation will provide each school with the Outdoor Adventures curriculum and equipment at no cost to the school.

The OTF will provide the following:

- McCarroll Middle School will receive the Fishing, Survival Skills, Orienteering equipment and curriculum package -https://gootf.com/product/4-fishing-survival-orienteering-pkg/
- Decatur High School will receive the NASP Plus Package https://gootf.com/product/1-nasp-plus-pkg/

The materials provided by the OTF supports K-12 Physical Education TEKS.

The OTF would like a statement from DISD stating the district will accept the gift, along with a thank you letter to share with the donor and a few pictures at the end of the year to verify some lessons were taught.

The Outdoor Adventures curriculum has 40 units with 360 lessons, no annual fees and every teacher can have access to the lessons. If DISD wishes to add future schools to the program, separate purchases or grants will be required.
