

AWARDS FOR ACHIEVEMENT

Determination of Valedictorian, and Salutatorian, for currently enrolled high school students, the selection of Valedictorian, and Salutatorian, will be determined at the end of the 2nd semester of the graduating class's senior year. The selection for Valedictorian, and Salutatorian will be determined based on an unweighted grade point scale. The student with the highest Grade Point Average (GPA) will be selected as Valedictorian. The student with the second highest GPA will be selected as the Salutatorian. GPA will be determined by PowerSchool, rounded to the ten-thousandths place (4 decimal points). If there is a tie in GPA, more than one Valedictorian, or Salutatorian, will be selected. Students earning a modified diploma, Certificate of Completion, are not eligible for Valedictorian, or Salutatorian, class ranking.

Students earning a modified diploma, Certificate of Completion, are not eligible for Valedictorian, or Salutatorian, class ranking.

- The determination will be made following 8 Semesters of high school classes.
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 classes, each semester, of your senior year.
- To be considered for Valedictorian or Salutatorian, you must have completed your Junior and Senior year in the North Slope Borough School District
- Courses must be for credit
- Study Hall credit will not be included in the GPA.
