BP 2100 Administrative Staff Organization

Authority originates with the publicly elected School Board and state laws and regulations. The Superintendent or designee may delegate authority and responsibility to the administrators and staff in accordance with law and Board policy.

The Superintendent or designee shall organize the administrative staff in a manner which best enables the district to provide an effective program of instruction.

Staff He/she may adjust staff responsibilities may be adjusted by the Superintendent to accommodate the district needs and/or individual capabilities.
