The following are donations under \$1000

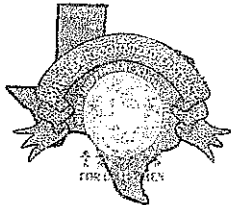
1. Kennedy-Zapata Elementary School received a donation of \$120.00 from H.E.B.
