- Vendor: Panorama Education Link emailed to each family Paper copies provided as needed




# Participation

- Family Responses
  - 2014 23.8% 125/525
  - 2016 51.7% 282/545
  - 2018 28.7% 163/567
  - 2019 25.9% 149/579
- Student Responses (3-6)
  - 2018 93.5% 444/475
  - 2019 91.8% 447/487
- Teacher and Staff Responses
  - 2018 90.3% 112/124
  - 2019 86.3% 113/131

The school differentiates instruction appropriately to meet my child's academic needs.	66%(82)	72%(88)	70%(82)	64%(75)
The amount and level of difficulty of homework given to my child is appropriate.	69%(77)	72%(80)	60%(75)	60%(70)
Beecher Road School provides students with healthy food choices.	46%(63)	67%(79)	64%(81)	53%(68)
My child's report card clearly communicates what my child is learning.	48%(63)	61%(76)	65%(82)	66%(78)

## Reflections

- Strongest results found in student responses
- Disappointment and surprise with decreased ratings in various areas including feedback to teachers/staff
- Timing of survey coincided with challenging events (budget, etc.)
- Differing responses based on staff experience level/student grade level
- Student gains positive but not as great as expected on target question
- Increase Superintendent contact with staff and families
- Maximize use of staff to enable administration to focus on instruction /feedback in classrooms
- Need for greater understanding of teacher/staff responses
- Work needed in climate, behavior and leadership/staff collaboration



## Initial Steps

- Share Surveys with Stakeholders
- Expand Administration/Staff Collaboration
- Create Staff Resource Handbook (Protocols, etc)
- Increase Administrator Visibility/Feedback
- Increase PD time for TA's
- Assess progress during year possible focus groups



## Continued Next Steps

### **Ongoing Strategies and Plans**

- Motivational/Inspiration Keynote Speaker for start of year
- Revised Student Behavior Protocols
- Created New Teacher/Staff Handbook
- Establish Weekly Collaboration/PD time for Teacher Assistants/Teacher
- Monthly meetings with Executive Boards/Admin Team, Team Leader Meetings and PLC Teams

Discuss/share/understand/respond to overall findings of Identified Major Focus Areas: Climate, Staff/Leadership Collaboration, Student Behavior Tier I Instruction



## Continued Next Steps

### **Ongoing Strategies and Plans (continued)**

- Established flexible satellite office in south portion of school
- Ongoing Professional Development in climate and student behavior
- Continue implementation of Strategic Development Plan
- Use of Faculty meetings for staff to share successes
- Continue and increase staff social opportunities (Quaterly Breakfasts, etc.)
- Safe School Climate Committee Action Plan BKindness Month Ongoing responsive classroom strategies at faculty mtgs Review of proactive behavioral strategies Maintain/Increase whole school events Peaceful Bus Initiative

 Revisit current survey process/ content as well as potential alternatives




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




## Staff Responses by Topic

### Target Question for Students


QUESTION
