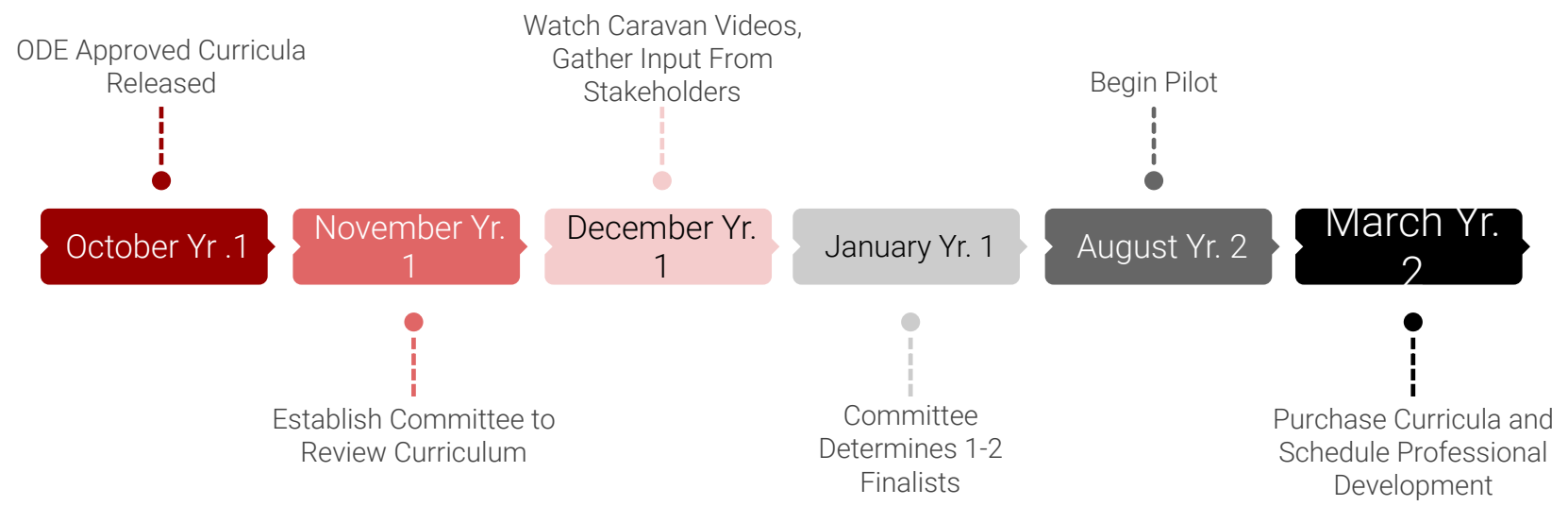

# Timeline



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# Step 1: Vision, Research, Standards, & Data

- Designed to get broad participation and understanding
  - Curriculum Area Vision
  - Reflection on Best Practices
  - Analysis of Oregon State Standards
  - Analysis of NKN student performance indicators
- Completed with building level groups
  - One cohort for elementary and another for secondary
- Involves: administrators, teachers
- Time commitment: 2-4 hours
- Meetings in December and January





## Step 2: Caravan Video Review & Candidate List Refinement

- Caravan Video links will be shared with all stakeholders interested in serving on the curriculum adoption committee
- Stakeholders provide feedback (form to be developed)
- Administrative team reviews feedback and refines list (as applicable)
  - Goal is to have 2-3, preferably no more than 4, curriculum presentations
- December
- Time commitment: 6-10 hours



## Step 3: Curriculum Presentations, Feedback, & Preliminary Determination

- Share information with curriculum review committee, review Oregon approved curriculum, & solicit feedback
- Share work of previous steps with the committee and explain the review process
- Participate in the Curriculum Presentations as offered by the companies
- Individual team members complete the rating form (ODE or NKN created)
- Input will be shared and committee will determine 1-2 finalists to pilot
  
- January
- Approximately 2 hours for each presentation/feedback, and another session to review feedback and determine finalist(s)

# Step 4: Pilot Lessons and Determine Alignment

- Dive deeper into the potential curriculum and explore areas of current emphasis and/or gaps
- Staff volunteer to pilot lessons in classroom
- Focused look at strands at each grade level
  - Option for teachers at each grade level to dive into the strands and standards alignment for each unit.
- August Year 2
- Time commitment: In class lesson and planning time, & PLC work times

## **Step 5: Administrative Review and Recommendation**

- Administration reviews the feedback from all stages
- Administration makes a recommendation to the Board
- February Board Meeting



# Step 6: Board Approval and Preparation

- Board approves a curriculum with input of administration
- Administration conducts purchasing and preparation for ongoing professional development and implementation
- February - August 2025
