

**Activities Director Report**December 9th, 2020**News/Notes:**

- Congratulations to our ExCEL Award winners for this year, Monica Stokman and David Ringhand.
 - ExCEL stands for – Excellence in Community, Education and Leadership. This high school league award is a unique recognition program designed exclusively for Minnesota high school juniors who are active in school activities, who show leadership qualities, and who work voluntarily in their community.
- Congratulations to our Triple “A” Award winners for this year, Lily Peterson and Colby Hanson.
 - The Academics, Arts, and Athletics Award, commonly known as the Triple 'A' Award, honors high school seniors throughout the state who have a 3.0 or higher-grade point average and who participate in League-sponsored athletic and fine arts activities.

Athletics/Activities Updates:

- The MSHSL Board of Directors approved three different models in anticipation for the restart of winter sports.
 - Possible practice start dates are Dec. 21st, Jan. 4th, and Jan. 18th. The earliest competitions could take place is Jan. 4th (with a Dec. 21st restart).
 - Moderate adjustments in the winter season are accounted for and are likely to result in minimal disruption to the spring sports seasons. Included in the scheduling models are weeks designated for section play and a potential state tournament.
 - The model also included a projected view of spring activities, maintain a traditional number of spring season contests and an end date of no later than June 19, 2021.
- We are still in a holding pattern as we wait to hear if Governor Walz’ extends Executive Order 20-99 or not.

Music Updates
