This program change necessitates a redirection of financial resources to meet the educational needs of the students resulting in the elimination of one full-time professional position within the secondary physical education program. Darrell Moore seconded the motion.

IN FORCE FOR

NECESSARY REDUCTION A motion was made by Becky Rentz and seconded by Terry Merck to accept the Superintendent's PROFESSIONAL STAFF recommendation to invoke a reduction in force in accordance with policy DFF (LOCAL), based on the board's determination that a program change in the secondary physical education program requires the elimination of one fulltime professional position.

The motion carried: 4 for, 0 against.

Becky Rentz made a motion to direct the superintendent to apply the criteria for decision set forth in policy DFF (LOCAL) to identify the employee subject to the reduction in force and to recommend proposed nonrenewal of that employee's term contract based on the reduction in force. Terry Merck seconded the motion.
