RE: Policy Revisions

At the BOE meeting on December 8, 2025, three policies were pulled from the consent calendar for further review and clarification. Here is a brief summarization of each policy to address the questions:

BP 2:150 – Committees: Two standing board committees were identified in this update:

1. Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee: This committee is covered in two areas: Title 1 Parent-Committee and ELL Parent Advisory Committee.
2. Behavioral Interventions Committee: This committee has met sporadically over the years, but not officially for several. After discussion, we will fold this committee as part of our standing student handbook committee, which periodically makes changes regarding behavior interventions. Any changes to the student handbook would then be brought to the BOE for review and approval.

It is recommended that the default “No” be adopted on the second page of the review.

BP 6:60 – Curriculum Content:

A specific question was brought about item #6, which had a substantial amount with strikethrough, leaving an incomplete sentence. To rectify this, “will occur” was added and item #6 should read: “In all grades, instruction will occur on behaviors that violate Board policy 7:180, *Prevention of and Response to Bullying, Intimidation and Harassment.*”

It is recommended that the default response “No” be adopted on the sixth page of the review.

BP 6:300 – Graduation Requirements:

A question was posed about why “methods of voting, and the Pledge of Allegiance” were struck from the policy. This was a law that was passed in the spring 2025 legislative session, thus the change. I am unsure “why” the law was changed. We still recite the “Pledge” on a daily instructional basis.
