**TOPIC:                                      Approval to Purchase Vehicles**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of four Ford F250 pickup trucks, three equipped with plows and one without a plow, and one Ford T250 Transit high roof, long wheel base van from Gorno Ford, Woodhaven Michigan, for a total cost of \$188,537.00.

**RATIONALE:**

These vehicles would replace the oldest vehicles in our maintenance fleet. The pickup trucks will be used by the District's departments of Maintenance, Grounds, and Transportation. The T250 Transit van will be utilized by the LCTC Building Trades program and purchased using CTE Added Cost funds.

Gorno Ford was the lowest responsible bidder on the MiDEAL Extended Purchasing Program.
