2025-26 Hazardous Walk Zones

## **CONSENT**

## **BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with Board Policy CNA (LEGAL) the district may apply to the Commissioner of Education for an additional amount of up to ten percent of its regular transportation allotment to be used for the transportation of students living within two miles of the school they attend who would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walk to school.

## **CONSIDERATIONS:**

Students living within two miles of the listed schools and within the listed designated hazardous walk zone are eligible for district transportation. The Transportation Department recently inspected previously designated hazard areas, along with new construction areas, and new attendance zones, to determine if any hazardous conditions remain following recent community improvements. Areas that were determined to no longer have qualifying road hazard conditions will not have bus service next year. The following resolution represents all of the MISD hazardous walk areas for the 2025-26 school year.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Superintendent recommends The Board approve the areas listed in Resolution 25-17 as hazardous walk zones for the 2025-26 school year.
