Parameters:

- ISD 622 Strategic Plan: All students will successfully meet academic standards.
- Alignment to the 2021 Minnesota Academic Standards in Social Studies & <u>ISD 622</u> Resource Review Rubric
- Teacher voice at the center of resource selection.
- ML, Student Services, and American Indian Education collaboration
- 6th grade will continue to use the current Northern Lights Minnesota Studies curriculum resource from the MN Historical Society: new version aligned to the 2021 Social Studies Standards will be released for SY 26-27

Recommendation

The 7th & 8th grade Social Studies CRTF recommends the adoption of: *McGraw-Hill United States History Voices & Perspectives, Exploring Geography & Global Issues*

- Strengths cited by teachers:
 - comprehensive and flexible design that supports both student engagement and instructional best practices
 - extensive primary sources from multiple perspectives, paired with focused, compelling questions that align with the Inquiry Design Model process
 - embedded teacher supports for meeting the needs of students receiving ML and SPED services
 - online platform features built-in supports, including read-aloud capabilities and differentiated reading levels
- Resolution for curriculum purchase, proposing multi-year agreement (6 years)
