# **Itinerary**

#### Houston is on the same time as Denton ISD

### Friday, May 20, 2016

Students will wear: Khaki Shorts and Performance Shirt (Band or Orchestra Shirt), and nice tennis shoes

You may wear sweat pants/wind pants over your shorts for the bus ride

Make sure to put your beach shoes in your bag for the bus

You will not have access to luggage stored under the bus until arriving in hotel room that night.

When you arrive at school:

# **Student Behavior Expectations**

Student behavior is of utmost importance. Students will treat all directors and chaperones with respect and follow directions.

All students must abide by the school handbook, as well as, your band or orchestra handbook.

### Here are a few more reminders:

- Remain seated on the bus at all times.
- You must sit with someone of the same gender at all times on the bus.
- Do not use the bathroom on the bus unless it is an absolute emergency.
- Do not spray, apply or use sun-screen, hairspray, deo, perfume, etc. Many people have severe allergies to these materials. Wait until you are off the bus before applying these materials.
- Voice levels must remain UNDER champs level one.
- If you listen to music, please use headphones and keep the volume to a minimum
- Be very quiet at all times at our performance venue. We will be at a high school when classes will be in session.
- Remember concert etiquette while sitting in the audience
- While at restaurants, be extremely courteous to everyone especially those not traveling with us.
- Be ON TIME or early to all your check in times. If you are not on time, you are done participating
  for the day and must remain with a director for the duration of the day.
- You must stay with your travel group at all times. If you are not with your specific group at any time, you are done participating for the day and must remain with a director for the duration of the day.
- Be quiet at all times in the hotel
- Do not over crowd the hotel elevator
- Do not run in the hotel

## Chaperones!

Thank you very much for giving your time.

We are glad you are here to help ensure students follow expectations, to facilitate loading/unloading, and guide students through the performance process. We have some special requests:

- Please remind students of proper bus behavior when necessary
- Please sit throughout the bus to help monitor students
- Please remind students of proper concert etiquette
- Please remind students to be courtesy and keep a reasonable noise level in restaurants
- Please be early for all events on the itinerary so that we can give you any updated information.
- Please set a good example of school approved swimwear if you choose to participate at Schlitterbahn
- If you have difficulties with student behavior, please contact a director
- Consequences for tardy check-in times or not in assigned groups are to remain with a director for the duration of the day.
- Please stick to the check-in times listed in the packet, as well as the consequences listed.
- Please check on student rooms at lights out time
- Meet in hotel lobby 10-15 minutes after lights out
- Please remind students to drink plenty of water and apply tons of sun-screen at every check-in.

<u>Swimsuits</u>. We would like to inform you of this policy now so your family can have some time to go shopping if necessary. Since this is a school sponsored trip, we will be observing the swimsuit guidelines below as we have always done. At Schlitterbahn, students may bring a swimsuit to wear that day. Girls must either wear a one piece swimsuit or a tankini with the tank top portion coming down to slightly overlap the bottom portion. Boys must wear swim trunks.
