## **Special Instructions**

At the beginning of the school year, each school district in Texas is required to review its class size enrollment to determine whether its class sizes for grades kindergarten (K) through four meet the requirements of TEC §25.112. If the review indicates that any class for grades K-4 exceeds the allowable class size limit of 22 students per class (22:1), the district must submit a request for exception under TEC §25.112(d). Enter the total number of sections and the reason(s) for the exception request. Class size limits do not apply to physical education or fine arts classes. The exception request must be submitted to TEA (Commissioner) no later than October 3, 2012 or the 30th day after the first school day the district exceeds the limit.
