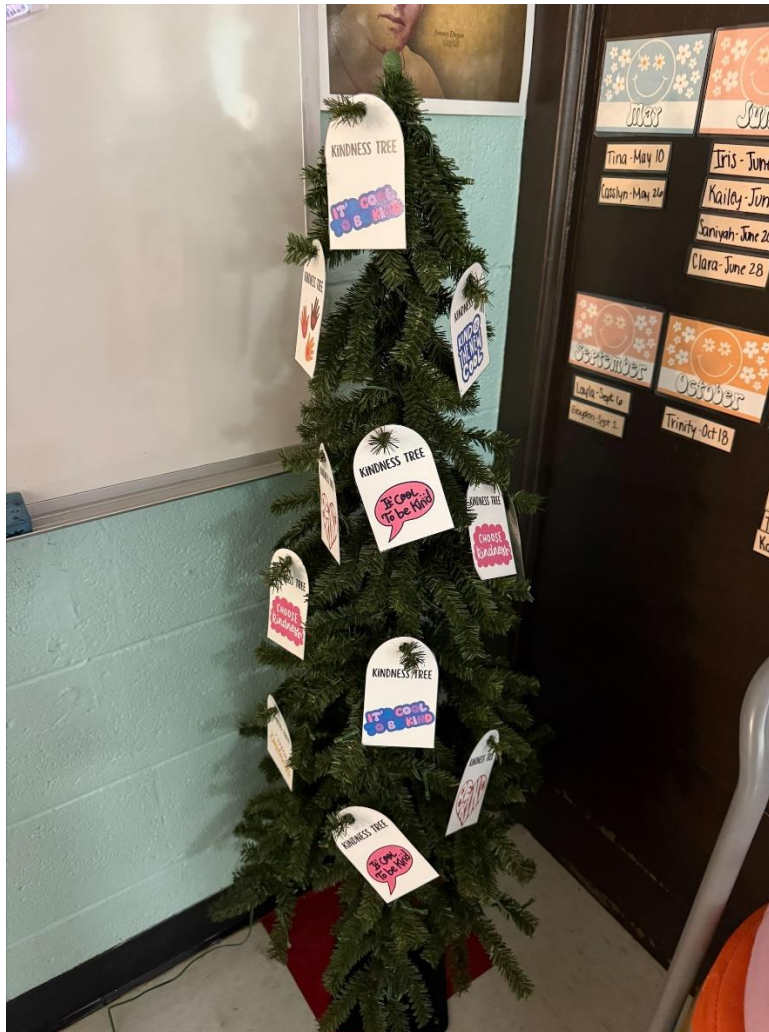
K-Kids support families in need this Thanksgiving!
