Re: Paving Bid Results

I would like the opportunity to discuss with the Board of Education information on the bid results for the summer 2025 paving projects at Central Office, Franklin High School, and the Bentley Track at the next Committee of the Whole meeting on March 10, 2025. The bid opening for this Sinking Fund project occurred on February 26, 2025, and post-bid interviews were conducted on March 4, 2025.

The recommended low responsible bidder is Best Asphalt, Inc., Romulus, Michigan, in the amount of \$1,318,872, which includes the base bid for paving at Central Office Complex and acceptance of both alternate bids for paving a portion of Franklin's student parking lot in the amount of \$258,494 and repaving the Bentley field track in the amount of \$94,859. We are recommending a 10% contingency amount of \$131,887 for a total Board approval amount of \$1,450,759. The recommended funding source for the paving project will be from the Sinking Fund.
