**Background Information:**

School districts are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that:

- for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and;
- the district’s technology and instructional materials allotment is used only for expenses allowed by the Texas Education Code.

**Administrative Considerations:**

The administration considered the following when working through the calendar development process:

- The certification must be ratified by the board of trustees in an open, public-noticed meeting before it is submitted to the Texas Education Agency (TEA).
