We started our 3rd cycle round of PDSA's on March 10, 2025 after our MTSS Meeting which was held on 3/4/2025. Progress monitoring pie charts were explained and shared in the previous board report. The teachers analyzed their WIN group data and made some adjustments for reteaching or moving forward. As a result 3 WIN intervention groups moved out of SIPPS Extension to adjust instruction to promote fluency and accuracy. Outliers were assessed by the coaches and regrouped based on data for WIN intervention. The first PDSA was completed on 3/24/25. On 3/26/25 teachers progress monitored their WIN groups and started their 2nd PDSA on 3/31/25.

The coaches provided professional development for Questioning in literacy focusing on Depth of Knowledge. How to and management for Grade Level Math Fluency. We continue to give support to teachers.


Music Club
