





    - Meningococcal conjugate
    - Meningococcal B
    - Hepatitis A
    - Measle, Mumps, Rubella
    - Polio
    - Varicella
  - 5 Program Sites:
    - New Tech Odessa
    - Nimitz Middle School
    - Bowie Middle School
    - Wilson & Young Medal of Honor Middle School
    - Murry Fly Elementary

- Provided over 300 vaccines to students
- Only school district west of Amarillo and Lubbock that provides this service

- Partnered with Ector County Health Department to provide COVID vaccines to children 5 to 11 years old
  - 2500 of Ector County's children ages 5 to 11 have received 1 dose of COVID vaccine
  - 21% of 1st dose vaccines provided to children 5 to 11 years old were given by ECSID RNs

High School Senior Completion Rates






