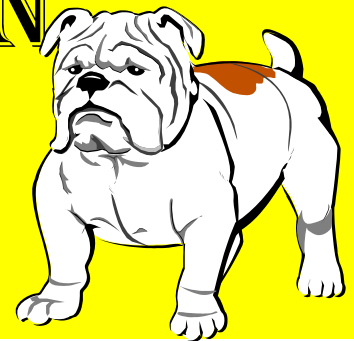

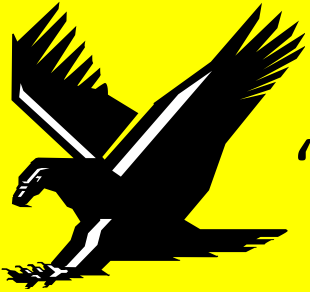
Action Steps 2011-2012

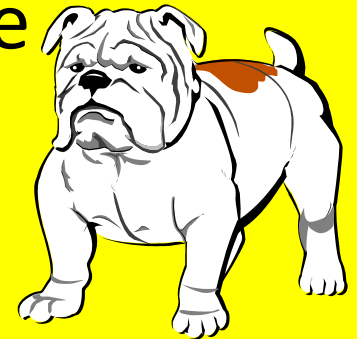
