## Dean Activities:

- Attendance Tardies: As of today April 10, 2019 the attendance is worse than same time last see attached. The goal is to maintain attendance at $84 \%$ overall we currently are at $74 \%$ for the school. The current trend can be attributed to lack of interest, parent fatigue, students see no or little value in their education. Letters, calls home and recent home visits have produced very little results.
- Discipline. The referrals I have gotten 17 stage 1 behaviors or class management issues and the process for handling these issues are laid out and follow a progression. 3 referrals resulted in ISS situations 3 resulted in suspensions. There currently 4 students behavior contract. There have been no tier 1or tier 2 wright up from the Jr. High.
- Bullying Prevention: The Jr. High and the High School have improved the reporting of bullying and harassment allowing me to intervene at the earliest stages. The intervention process is still in place and has been successful in investigating, addressing and deterring bullying behavior. I have intervened on 6 reported cases of bullying all of which had roots in social media (Face Book, Snap Chat etc.) 5 were been resolved and 1 ended in suspension.
- Duties: the duty schedule that I maintain is rigorous and consumes the majority of my time, I attempt to walk the halls at least twice a period and observe at least every class once in the morning and once in the afternoon logging 7 miles daily.
- Student Recognition: the "Star Student" program is still in place with the continuation of the star board tied to rewards. Student of the week process is continuing to develop however the continuity is in its infancy I will strive to work out the details.
