Agenda Item: Consider Approval of Resolution to Pay Employees During School Closures for Severe Weather on January 26-30, 2026.		
<p>Summary:</p> <p>District policy EB (LOCAL) gives the Superintendent authority to close schools for public health and safety reasons. Severe weather conditions from January 26 - 30, 2026, compelled the Superintendent to close District facilities for the safety of students and employees. The District will make up January 27, 2026, date on March 27, 2026, as one of the planned bad weather days. The District had enough minutes in the calendar to close on January 26, 2026, without scheduling a make-up day. District policy states that employees shall continue to be paid for their regular duty schedule during closures, and following the emergency closure, the Board shall adopt a resolution establishing the purpose and parameter for the payments.</p>
