	Summary:	This authorization will allow the District to avoid potential delays and will allow for the construction process to continue in a timely manner if changes are needed. Any individual change that exceeds the \$200,000 threshold will be brought before the Board for approval. The board will be updated on all changes requested using the contingency allowance in order to see all savings/uses of such funds. Additionally, the board will receive updates on all cost savings. Any items cut from the budget originally that may be brought back due to contingency savings will be brought to the board before bringing the items back to the construction plan. Any items that would go over the adopted GMP would have to be brought to the board for approval.				
	Background Information	The District authorized the Superintendent in May of 2023 to approve change orders for the New High School Construction not to exceed \$200,000. This authorization expedited necessary construction work without requiring special board meetings to be called or delaying the project.
