SUMMARY:

This item requests approval to extend RFP #2002-03 Career and Technology Education Supplies, Services, Equipment, Repair for a term of one year.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

RFP #2002-03 CTE Supplies, Equipment, Repair & Services was awarded on March 24, 2020, to ninety-four (94) vendors. The initial award was for one (1) year, with the option to extend for one (1) additional one-year term.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The current award expires on March 31, 2021.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The District has a wide and dynamic range of needs for Career and Technical Education supplies, services, equipment, and repairs. All purchases will be made on an "as needed" basis.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by the appropriate department or campus fund.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow the District to maintain its base of vendors who can provide Career and Technical Education supplies, services, equipment, and repairs for current and future needs.

It is recommended that RFP #2002-03 Career and Technology Education (CTE) Supplies, Services, Equipment, Repair be extended for the final renewal term of one-year (1) beginning April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022.
