# College Readiness - GISD Opportunities

- Earn Dual Credit (3 hrs in math or RLA OR 9 hrs in other subject)
- Complete OnRamps Dual Enrollment Course
- Graduate under an Advanced Diploma Plan as current SPED student
- Meet TSI criteria in at least one selection from RLA AND one selection from math
- Earn credit by completing both College Prep ELA AND College Prep Math (currently utilizing Texas College Bridge in partnership with Navarro)

# Career Readiness

- Earn an Industry Based Certification (IBC) within program of study and complete pathway (Program of Study)
- Earn a Level I OR II Certificate
- Graduate with an IEP AND Workforce Readiness Code

# Military Readiness

- Enlist in the Armed Forces OR Texas National Guard

# Current CCMR Status of GHS Students

Currently **68 out of 114** seniors are CCMR complete (60%)

Seniors currently on track to earn CCMR point:

- 4 planning to join the national guard/army
- 24 planning to achieve through TSI or College Prep Math & English (TCB)
- 13 planning to earn an IBC and complete their pathway
- 2 IEP or workforce readiness graduation code

# CCMR Senior Course Overview

**24** students are currently enrolled in Pathway to College and Career course

## Course Objectives:

- Provide academic and social support to help prepare students for post graduation for both career and/or college.
- Focus on developing habits and skills expected and needed for college study and in the workforce.
- Testing preparation for SAT/ACT and TSI
  - TSI scores are required for college/university/trade school enrollment
- Opportunity to complete Texas College Bridge ( completion can serve as a waiver for the TSI)
- College application, career application, and scholarship application support

# Other Activities in Pathway to Career/College Class

- Communication Skills
- Interview Skills
- Resume Building
- Future Planning
- College Decision Making
- Scholarship Applications
- Among Other Things

# Status of the Pathway to Career/College Class

- 15/24 have passed one section of the TSI
- 7/24 have passed more than one section of the TSI
- Students will continue to have the opportunity to test each month
- Those not TSI complete will then complete Texas College Bridge in the Spring to earn both their:
  - CCMR point (by earning college prep English/math credit)
  - waiver for college for the TSI
