

Hello, All,

As I will not be able to attend ADM meeting next week, I will just address my topics via this E-mail. Please read carefully and make note of those things you need to address.

- 1. <u>MANDATORY STAFF TRAININGS</u>--Please send these sign-in sheets to me ASAP. Before sending, please ensure that 100% of your staff has documented completion by signing this form. We have LABC. (This is to inform you if you have already completed and that's all.)
- TITLE I MEETINGS--We need three things from your Title I meetings: Agenda, Minutes, and Sign-in Sheets. If you need examples, please go to website under Departments: Instructional Services: Resources. We have all items from LABC, Capitol, South and LMS. LHS, please submit after your open house.
- 3. <u>PARENT & FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY</u>—Please send your latest copy of what was called the Parent Involvement Policy. There is a name change because of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). So, if you have to print it out, please go ahead and change the name to Parent & Family Engagement Policy. We have none of these.

- CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT—These are also fall workshops.

- 8. <u>FEDERALLY FUNDED EMPLOYEES ON YOUR CAMPUSES</u>—These are the staff members on your campus who are funded with federal funds. These are the ones who will need to complete Time & Effort documents—I will bring to campus when needed and your office staff has been very helpful in getting signatures and returning. The exception is Head Start staff who are not listed.
- 9. FREE & REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS—We hope that you made a valiant effort to get these at the beginning of the year. THIS IS HUGE FOR SO MANY THINGS—E-rate, lunch charges, etc.!!!
- 10. <u>HOMELESS LIAISONS</u>—Finally, complete this form at meeting and turn in as designated. It is normally office staff and/or counselors. We will train them soon.
