Pursuant to MCSD Policy IICA, the Morrow County School District Talented and Gifted Program request approval for the following TAG field trip:

- 1. Name of club/organization: MCSD Talented and Gifted Program
- 2. Number of students: Approximately 10(exact number to be determined when all signed permission slips are returned)
- 3. Number of adult chaperones: 2, one male and one female
- 4. Destination of trip: Seattle, WA
- Distance and number of days (Any school days?): 298 miles, 4 days, departing on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup>(school day) and returning on Sunday, March 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Transportation plan: A district car and van will be used. Transportation provided by two approved Type 20 trained MCSD employees.
- 7. Purpose of trip: Provide learning opportunities for identified Talented and Gifted students in grades 9-12 in MCSD.

Brief Description: The Morrow County School District TAG coordinators are planning a trip to Seattle for high school TAG students. They are planning on leaving March 8<sup>th</sup> and returning March 11<sup>th</sup>.
