This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into between the Eagle Pass Independent School District and Southwest Texas Junior College Workforce Education Division, for the purpose of establishing a collaboration and coordination for the provision of the selected training services to be offered during the 2016-2017 school year.

Eagle Pass Independent School District will:

- Provide a fully-executed Memorandum of Understanding to cover all students to be enrolled in the program prior to the start of the class;
- Adhere to Southwest Texas Junior College refund policy;
- Enforce adherence to admission requirements as well as program policies and procedures, specifically regarding attendance to meet the minimum 60 clock hours of classroom instruction and 40 clock hours of clinical experience, as specified in the Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services Nurse Aide Training Requirements;
- Facilitate student participation in training/clinical site during the school day and/or weekend and provide transportation;
- Facilitate student participation in practicum training for Phlebotomy Program during the school day and/or weekend and provide transportation;
- Facilitate student participation in practicum training for Phlebotomy Program during the school day and/or weekend and provide transportation;
- Inform students of course schedule:
- Provide paperwork of all enrollment requirements listed above within 15 days
 after the course start date. Any student that does not provide all paperwork will
 be officially dropped from the course.
- Pay the certification exam fees for each student enrolled in the program(s) and provide transportation to the test site;
- Pay for retesting fees, if agreed upon;
- Inform students and enforce uniform requirement for clinical rotations and/or classroom, as applicable;
- Provide student textbooks/workbooks, equipment, and consumable supplies for all programs;
- Be responsible for any photocopies needed.
- Provide access to the Frank Chisum Regional Technical Center on weekends as necessary for instructional or exam purposes.

Southwest Texas Junior College Workforce Education Division will:

- Provide qualified instructors and state approved Program Director for each instructional component;
- Facilitate curriculum for applicable components;
- Be responsible for providing adequate practicum skills lab for Phlebotomy component;
- Be responsible for scheduling the certification exams;
- Oversee and submit the necessary paperwork for the Nurse Aide State Exam;
- Pay the Program Director fee;
- Facilitate student retests, if necessary;
- Conduct a criminal history and Nurse Aide Registry check of each student in the program as required by the Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services;
- Conduct a criminal history check of each student in the Phlebotomy program;
- Provide student identification badges for clinicals;
- Provide student performance updates/grades upon request;
- Issue Semester Credit Hours upon successful completion of program.
- Provide First Aid & CPR instruction and certification.
