We have shared our school wide Aimsweb data with all teachers. We did not meet our 95% goal, so the discussion has been started on what refinements can happen in January to hopefully increase testing completion. ELA data is looking pretty good but lots of refinement has to happen in the Math area. BHS is already working with BMS on how to address the math and transitioning students to the high school programs.

What's Happening At BHS:

- Counselors are working with grade level advisor teachers and going into classrooms and giving Tier 1 lessons. Some lessons are SEL and others are Academic Counseling. Counselors are getting ready for the semester so they are beginning to meet with students to discuss classes for 2nd semester. During our Responsive Friday the guidance counselors are creating Tier 2 groups that will meet and lessons are taught on Tier 2 group needs. They also continue to meet 1 on 1 with some students with Tier 3 counseling. BHS are still referring students to Gina Dosch, Daniella and Kathy for severe Tier 3 needs. The referral system is going great and students are able to meet with a counselor weekly or more if needed.
- BHS administration and Instructional Coaches are working with Terri Barclay to look at our MTSS tiered supports and align it to the district. It has created good conversations on all the positive things we do have in place, but there is places we need to dig deeper and put more strategic things in place, especially true tutoring.
- Instructional coaches are continuing to work with new teachers and previous teachers and have coaching cycles going to the staff that need the extra support. On November 12th and 13th we will have teachers completing Instructional Rounds. This is a form of observing other teachers and then giving staff time to discuss the classroom and get questions answered. We have a schedule for Science and Math teachers and a schedule for ELA and Social Studies teachers.
- BHA and BHS are continuing working together for students and what is best for them. We still have our referral list and hopefully at 2nd semester we may be able to get a few more into BHA.
- MTDA- students are doing a great job. Mrs. Andreas does an amazing job supporting students with the rigorous classes. MTDA just completed an interview on Callie Wood and her using MTDA and what it has done for her. Mrs. Andreas has been collecting data on MTDA over the years and will share it soon with BHS admin.

- Responsive Friday- November 15th. We have a new system in how we have teachers and students sign up and it has helped with teacher accountability and student signing up early.
