Re: LCTC Cooperative Agreements

For many years, the Livonia Public Schools has opened the enrollment doors of our Career Technical Center to students from surrounding school districts through Cooperative Agreements. Cooperative Agreements provide a mutually beneficial arrangement that allow surrounding districts to offer our LCTC classes to their students. In return, a proportional amount of the sending district's student funding allocation is redirected to the Livonia Public Schools. On an annual basis approximately 75-90 students from other districts have attended classes at the LCTC.

To be clear, all LPS student requests to attend the LCTC are honored before students from other districts are awarded seats. Transportation and special education services remain the responsibility of the sending district. In addition, our Cooperative Agreement with the Wayne Westland Community Schools allows LPS students to attend classes at the William Ford Career Technical Center.

Our Cooperative Agreements for the 2020-21 school year will include the Northville, Plymouth-Canton, Wayne-Westland, Crestwood, and Redford Union school districts, as well as Canton Prep High School.
