## 12 Week Attendance Report

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### Board Goal

#### IV. Parent and Community Involvement

In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

### Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the first 12 weeks of 2014/2015 (October 6, 2014 – November 7, 2014).

### Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 24 days (October 6 – November 7).

### Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

### Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the 12 week period is 96.36%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12<sup>th</sup> graders at 93.94% followed by 11<sup>th</sup> graders at 94.67%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade at 97.28% followed by 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders tied at 97.18%.
- Comparison:       2013's second grading cycle was 96.54%  
                              2012's second grading cycle was 96.52%.
