

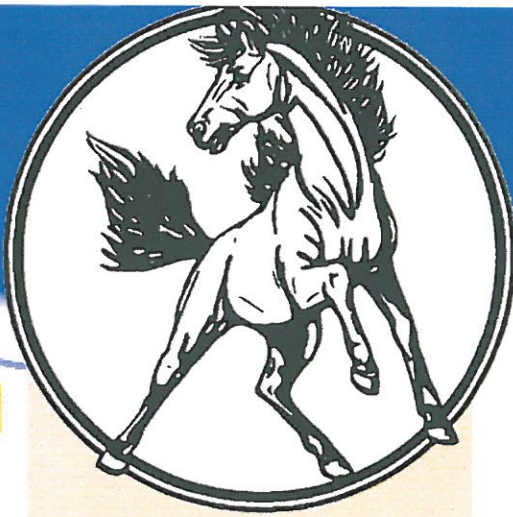

'Tis the season and time where transition to the second quarter and transcribed grades from the semester are of utter importance. Of course this starts with conversing with your son or daughter at home. We understand, when parents and guardians ask what happened in school today, all too often the answer is "nothing." I can assure you that if you prod a bit more, your student will probably share something from their escapade that we call school which in turn helps in holding our students accountable

When a student starts school as a freshman and they struggle to pass five or more classes their first year in school, they compound the struggle with credit acquisition over four years that is directly tied to graduation. We have spent much energy the last couple of years focusing on transition of our freshman and extending additional supports through the following years. As we near the winter break, it is my hope that you will help us with this mini transition. Students will be away for a couple of weeks and it is very important for them to finish strong prior to December 18<sup>th</sup> so that transition back in January becomes less stressful. 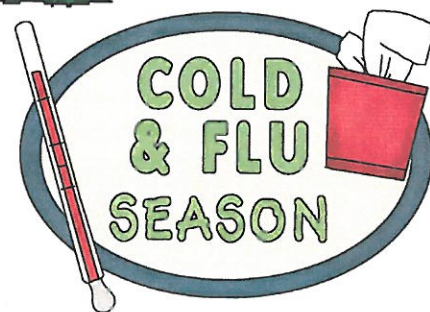

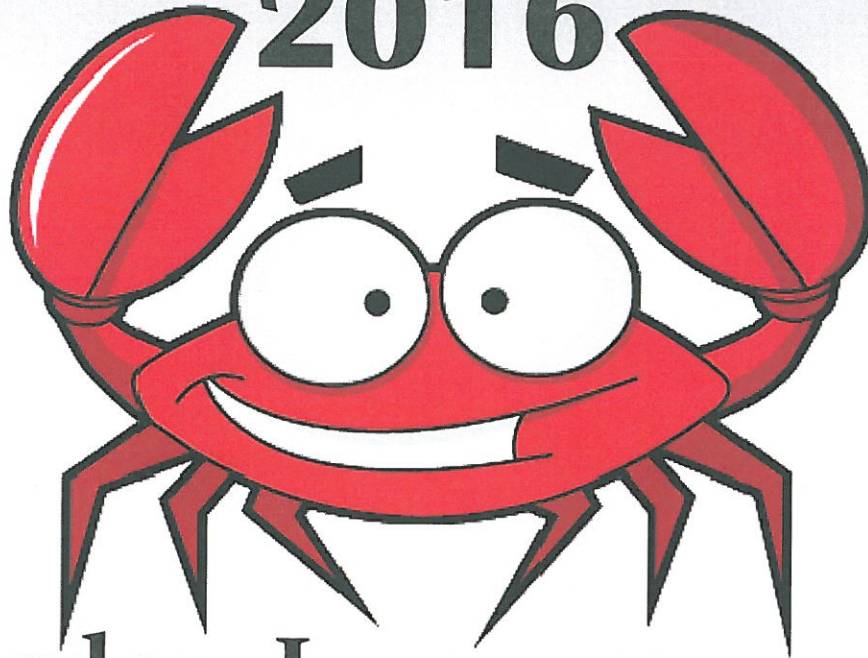
