Continuous Improvement Plan 2024-2025

Goal 1-Objective 1: FIS will increase from 39% scoring at or above grade level to 42% at or above grade level by end of year. **Results**: 36.5% *Strength Area*: 68% of student met typical growth in 6th Grade

Objective 2: FIS will increase from 42nd median percentile achievement to 45th median percentile by end of year in Reading MAP. **Results**: 48th median percentile.

Objective 3: FIS will increase ELA MAP Median Percentile Achievement from 13.25th to 16.25th in ELA and 11.25th to 14.25th in Math with our Special Education Students. **Results**: ELA-19.25th Math-16.25th

Goal 2-Objective 1: FIS will increase the number of hands-on, project-based learning opportunities for 5th and 6th graders during the 24-25 school year by completing 2 (Project Based Learning). **Results**: Met

Objective 2: FIS will provide professional development and exemplify Portrait of a Learner by doing quarterly awards with the four POL domains. **Results**: Met

Objective 3: FIS will reduce Chronic Absenteeism from 39.4% to 36.4% by the end of school year. **Results**: 43% (Infinite Campus data)

Objective 4: Based on the data that 68% of students at FIS indicate that they can easily employ their social emotional skills, 71% of FIS students will report employing SEL skills. **Results**: 67% (Note: 48% of FIS students took survey)

Continuous Improvement Plan 2025-2026

Goal 1: In grades 5th and 6th, at least 58% of students at Fernley Intermediate School will meet or exceed their personal typical growth in math and reading from the Beginning of Year (BOY) assessment to the End of Year (EOY) i-Ready assessment during the 2025/2026 school year.

Goal 2: Fernley Intermediate School will increase the total number of 5th and 6th Grade work-based learning opportunities provided to all students by 10% from 2024/2025 school year to the 2025/2026 school year.

Goal 3: Fernley Intermediate School will increase the total number of 5th and 6th Grade students participating in work-based learning opportunities provided to all students by 10% from 2024/2025 school year to the 2025/2026 school year.

Goal 4: Fernley Intermediate School will reduce the chronic absenteeism rate by 10% from the 2024/2025 school year to the 2025/2026 school year.

Goal 5: 100% of Fernley Intermediate School staff will participate in iReady, HMH, PBIS, MTSS, and Work-Based Learning/Project-Based Learning professional development.

Goal 6: 100% of Fernley Intermediate School staff will participate in PLCs (Professional Learning Communities), Data Dig Meetings, and collaboration with department teams.
