#### PARKROSE MS PROFILE: Spoken Languages






#### ELPA Assessment

- 135 number of students tested (some had never taken ELPA before; most had history)
- 17.8% (24 students) passed the test
- 24.5% (23 students) intermediate students who moved up to early advanced level
- 77.7% (73 students) posted gains from their previous score
- 17% (16 students) had a decrease from their previous score
- 5.3 % (5 students) had no change from their previous score


