

### **Background Information**

In compliance with Senate Bill 13, Midway ISD has adopted a Collection Development Policy that provides guidance for the selection, evaluation, and maintenance of library resources. The policy also establishes clear standards and procedures for collection development, including the process for recommending new materials.

As part of this process, the Board of Trustees is responsible for reviewing the list of library materials that have been either donated or proposed for procurement. Each Board member has the opportunity to propose changes prior to Board action. The Board may then approve or reject the recommended materials.

State law requires the Superintendent to make the list of proposed library materials available to the public at least 30 days before the Board's vote. Midway ISD will fulfill this requirement by posting the list on the Library Services webpage for public review during the 30-day period, ensuring that parents and community members have the opportunity to review the recommendations in advance of Board action.

### **Timeline**

- **February 17, 2026** – A list of proposed library materials will be presented to the Board of Trustees.
- **February 17, 2026** – The list of proposed library materials will be published on the Midway ISD Library Services webpage for public review.
- **March 24, 2026** – The Board of Trustees will vote to approve or reject the recommended library materials.
