What is an EEO-5 Report?

- Joint requirement of the U.S. Equal Opportunity Commission (EEOC) and the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) of the Department of Education. It is part of a mandate under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- Conducted biennially, in the even numbered years, and covers all public schools.
- Indicates the composition of the work forces by gender and race/ethnic category.
- Data is used for purposes including enforcement, selfassessment by employers, and research.




