The Appraisal District Board of Directors will appoint Review Board members by a majority vote and record their decision in a resolution. Terms begin January 1 and Review Board members serve a two-year staggered term. The Review Board member receives \$87.50 minimum for a half-day and a maximum pay of \$175.00 per day.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

To serve on the Appraisal Review Board, a person must reside in the appraisal district for at least two years prior to the date he or she takes office. The Comptroller's office will provide a course for training appraisal review board members.
