GPA / CLASS RANKING – MISSION OF WORK

Determine GPA and Class Ranking calculation and reporting system best designed to meet needs of Aledo ISD students

GPA / CLASS RANKING – SCOPE OF WORK

- Review current Aledo ISD GPA and Class Ranking policy
 - Explore benefits and limitations of current policy
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GPA / CLASS RANKING – SCOPE OF WORK

- Examine GPA and Class Ranking policy in other districts
 - Determine if changes to current Aledo ISD policy should be considered
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GPA / CLASS RANKING – SCOPE OF WORK

- Create recommendations for changes, as necessary
 - Solicit community input on proposed changes
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GPA / CLASS RANKING – SCOPE OF WORK

- Consider community input and make adjustments to proposed changes, as necessary
 - Submit recommendations to trustees for possible amendments to existing policy, as necessary
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GPA / CLASS RANKING – KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Basis for ranking
 - Exclusions
 - Weight categories
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GPA / CLASS RANKING – MEETING TIMELINE

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GPA / CLASS RANKING – FUTURE TIMELINE

- **March 21:**
Parent Informational meeting to share proposed changes, reasons for considering changes, and timeline for proposed phase-in, Q & A
 - **March 25 – April 12:**
Survey to collect community feedback available at Aledoisd.org
 - **April 18 (and any other meetings necessary):**
Follow-up committee meeting (to include parents and students) to evaluate feedback from survey and amend proposed changes as necessary

- Bring proposal with final amendments to EIC (Local) to Trustees for review
