Emergency Extended Care

Credit: .5

Prerequisite: Successful completion of EMR

Course description:

Emergency, Emergency! Imagine responding to an emergency situation and having the life-saving skills to save another person's life. Students will learn to apply skills learned in the Emergency Medical Responder course. Students will prepare to gain certification as a CPR trainer, learn essential skills related to athletic training and apply these skills to athletic situations, learn the essentials related to rope and rescue, and introductory firefighting rescue concepts and principles. This hands-on course will advance students' skills in the area of emergency care fields and provide opportunities to pursue careers in the medical responder fields.

Learner outcomes:

- 1. Meet the requirements of the basic rope and rescue course as approved by MnSCU office of the Chancellor.
- 2. Understand the different rope types and load capabilities used in rescue.
- 3. Students will demonstrate knot tying and rigging for rescue situations.
- 4. Students will demonstrate proper maintenance of ropes and equipment.
- 5. Demonstrate competency in rappelling, patient packaging, basket/litter/SKED rigging and tending.
- 6. Students will learn the basic skills and knowledge necessary to sports medicine and athletic training.
- 7. Students will perform basic and advanced taping and wrapping techniques.
- 8. Students will learn introductory firefighting skills and principles.
