








Percent of Students at **Approaches** Grade Level


Percent of Students at **Meets** Grade Level


Percent of Students at **Masters** Grade Level


## School Progress: Annual Growth


# ATTENDANCE AND GRADUATION INDICATORS






# SECTION 1: TAPR REPORT

## 2024 - 2025

### Highlights:

- District student growth in Math is only 2 points behind the region and 4 points behind the state.
- **Attendance increased to 91% from 90.1% the previous year.**

### In Progress:

- While the gap in Approaches standard is smaller, Meets and Masters performance remains below region and state levels. Through continuous improvement of instruction and data use, the district will support ongoing academic achievement and growth for all students.

## Highlights:

- The majority of district expenditures are directed toward instruction, with over **56% of operating expenditures supporting classroom instruction**, reflecting a continued focus on student learning.
- Local and state revenues remain the primary funding sources, providing stable operational support while maintaining tax rates below the state average.

## In Progress:

- Per-student expenditures remain below state averages, reinforcing the importance of maximizing efficiency while continuing to advocate for equitable funding.
- The district continues to refine financial processes to ensure accuracy, consistency, and alignment between the Annual Financial Report and PEIMS financial data.

# SECTION 7: PROGRESS TOWARD MEETING BOARD ADOPTED HB 3 GOALS 2024-2025

## Highlights:

- The percentage of 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade students who performed at the **MEETS level or above on the 2025 Math STAAR test is 4 points above** the 2025 HB 3 target.
- The percentage of Pre-kindergarten students that scored **“on track” on the CIRCLE assessment is the same** as the 2025 HB 3 Target.
- Percentage of graduates that **met the criteria for Dual Credit 6 points above the target.**

## In Progress:

- The percentage of SSAISD graduates that are considered CCMR is significantly below the target.
- The percentage of students who meet grade level expectations on their reading screener is significantly below the target.
