Curriculum

End-of-Year Records & Beginning of Year Draft Schedules: Teachers and Principals will have early release time on May 8th and 9th to work together to create draft schedules for FY26 and finalize records for students. May 10th will be a final work day with the goal to finish the year with clear documentation, so teachers have the information they need to start the school year in a good way in August.
