## Attendance

#### Attendance Procedure/Policy---

Oregon state law mandates regular school attendance by stating: "All students between the ages of 7 and 18, are required to attend school unless otherwise exempted by law. School staff will monitor and report violations of the state compulsory attendance law."

\*\*Signed notes are largely preferred when confirming a legitimate absence.

\*\*Parents should confirm legitimate student absences by phone, email or signed note within 3 school days of the absence.

#### Legitimate Absences:

Examples of legitimate absence(s) from school include the following:

Illness of the student;

Illness of an immediate family member when the student's presence is necessary;

Emergency situations that require the student's absence;

Field trips and school approved activities;

Medical and dental appointments (It is strongly encouraged to make appointments at times outside the school day)

Other reasons deemed appropriate by the school administration or attendance office when arrangements have been made in advance of the absence.

Regular attendance is absolutely essential to learning and success in school. North Valley High School strives to maintain high attendance rates by providing challenging schedules and rigorous curriculum to students. It should be recognized that every absence from class adversely affects a student's learning and may result in a loss of credit. With this in mind, students who do not maintain a satisfactory attendance rate of 92% or better in each class will be subjected to formal evaluation by school administration and staff. Student attendance, behavior and performance will be focused upon to determine a proper action/discipline measures by the school.

For the general health of the students at North Valley High School, we do not want students who are ill to be in school especially if they are contagious.

#### Leaving school during the school day (Checking Out)—

Once you have arrived at school your attendance is required in all classes. If you need to leave for any reason you must check out with the attendance office staff. This includes leaving school during the lunch period for a legitimate purpose when you will be late or missing subsequent classes.

## Adverse Weather

#### ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

#### Straight Line Routes For:

#### North Valley, Fleming, Manzanita, Fort Vannoy and Wolf Creek

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJO, KLDR, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the 3 Rivers School District Web Page for information on school bus schedules.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below.

If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.



## From the Librarian

Welcome to 2011-2012 school year From the LIBRARY

- Here is some basic information for you.....
- There is **NO** food or drink allowed in the Library. If you have water with a lid on, it is allowed.
- **Do not bring food or liquid in to the computer labs**; water must stay in your backpack, never near the computers.
- Students are allowed to check out up to 4 books if you are responsible. The check-out period is for 2 weeks but you can renew for longer if there is no one waiting on the book. Magazines are checked out for 1 week at a time but they can be renewed too. There are overdue fees of .05 per day until the book or magazine is returned or the fine reaches \$5.00. I do not need the book to renew your checkout and avoid the fines. Just stop by my desk and we can make sure and keep your account free of fines.
- You can use the computers to check for books in your library. After you log in go to the Destiny program and search. If you do not see what you need please ask and I will do my best to help you.
- We have a shelf of obsolete books in the Library that are free for you to take. These books are next to the wood bin that is the lost and found.
- The computer lab in the library is open at 7:30 and closes at 4pm, please check with the librarian to make sure that someone will be there if you need to use the lab before or after school.
