Prescott SUN/Self Enhancement Inc.

- 85 students participating; 4 days per week
- First hour of Academic Support-Reading, Math, Writing
- Second hour-Homework Club, Computer Club, Gym one, Rhythm & Movement, Calligraphy, Boys Group, Girls Group, Media Kids, etc.
- Supper provided

Russell and Sacramento-Boys and Girls Club

- Each school has about 60 students participating; 4 days per week
- One hour of Core Academic Support-Reading, Math, Writing
- One hour of Enrichment-Character Building, Leadership, Healthy Lifestyles
- Supper provided

Shaver SUN/Metropolitan Family Services

- 100 students participating regularly; 4 days per week
- Core Academic Support for first hour
- 7 Enrichment classes to choose from each day for second hour. Examples include: Lego Engineering, Soccer, Youth for Unity, Origami, Young Scientists, Drumming, Cooking
- Boys and Girls Club partners to support afterschool offerings
- Supper provided and school bus at end of program

Parkrose Middle School SUN/International Refugee Community Organization

- Meet 3 days per week in Fall 2:40-4:00, 4 days Winter and Spring 2:40-5:00
- Academic Support includes Homework Club, AVID Tutoring, Science Club
- Enrichment classes include Soccer, Girls Inc., Chess, SUN Student Advisory, Sexual Assault Prevention Class. More to come.
- Supper and Activity bus provided

Parkrose High School SUN/Portland Parks and Recreation

- Meet 5 days per week
- Offerings for community-Zumba class, Mat Club (Wrestling), Computers for 60+, Table Tennis, Cheerleading, Creative Writing
