Background Information:

Keller ISD contracts with the City of Fort Worth for twelve (12) School Resource Officers (SROs). The 2025-2026 school year assignments for the twelve (12) SROs are as follows: two (2) at Central High School, two (2) at Timber Creek High School, two (2) at Fossil Ridge High School, one (1) at Hillwood Middle School, one (1) at Trinity Springs Middle School, one (1) at Timberview Middle School, one (1) at Fossil Hill Middle School, one (1) at Vista Ridge Middle School and one (1) Mobile SRO.

Administrative Considerations:

The total cost to the district will be \$1,489,735.96 for the 2025-2026 school year. This represents a \$70,129.50 (4.7%) increase from last year. This increase is related to the Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated salary increases for City of Fort Worth police officers.
