



## **KAUFMAN ISD - MAINTENANCE REPORT**


### **SEPTEMBER 2025**


The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition, there were over 400 work orders completed during the month of September.

Here are a few of the projects that the team has been working on this past month:




A new set of Kaufman Lion flags were added to the stadium. The crew also took some time to pressure wash the stands as well as the concrete area around the stadium and the concession stands.

**Roof repairs were done to the office area at Nash Elementary School. The coating was applied using a special technique and should prevent leaks in that area for many years to come.**




**In August, there was a lightning strike (caught on camera) just outside of Phillips Elementary School. Fortunately, no one was hurt.**
