SUBJECT: Amendment to Student Code of Conduct

Background Information:

- The Student Code of Conduct was revised for the 2025-2026 school year after major changes took place during the 89th legislative session.
- The revisions were extensive; therefore, BISD utilized the TASB Model Student Code of Conduct as a basis for the 2025-2026 SCOC.
- Students who are assigned to the DAEP (Disciplinary Alternative Education Program) have the right to appeal the DAEP placement.
- The DAEP placement appeal historically had two levels: first with the campus Principal, followed by the second with a panel of three administrators designated by the Superintendent.

Administrative Considerations:

- The TASB Model Student Code of Conduct did not include the local provision of DAEP Appeals going through the previously adopted process.
- The 2025-2026 Model has the disciplinary appeals following the FNG (Grievance) process, which ultimately goes to the Board of Trustees at Level III.
- The intent for the 2025-2026 Student Code of Conduct was to continue the policy of level I and level II as in the previous years; however, the transfer of this language was not added to the 2025-2026 SCOC.
- The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the Amendment to the Student Code of Conduct as presented.
