## **Kindergarten**

We have many new concepts coming up in math, like comparing numbers 0-20. In reading we are working on skills that help us learn about expository texts. We had a great community field trip with stops at our library and our HHS Ag Barn before having lunch at the park. The in town trip followed a farm animal unit we had just completed.

## First Grade

In math, we will extend everything we've learned about adding and subtracting. The students will solve word problems and number sentences with up to three numbers! In ELAR, the students will determine what words mean from how they are used in a sentence, either heard or read. They will learn that we use capital letters for proper nouns like days, months, and holidays. In science and social studies, the students will be looking at natural resources and describing the human characteristics we need to survive.

## **Second Grade**

We had a great time getting to participate in Career Day at HIS. This month in math we will be classifying, sorting and creating two and three dimensional shapes based on their attributes. In science we will be exploring magnets and identify how they are used in everyday life. In 2nd grade ELAR we'll start off with using context clues to work on idioms then we will put our persuasive writing and letter writing skills to good use by writing Santa letters. We'll also continue to learn new things in Neuhaus phonics and work hard toward our AR goals.
