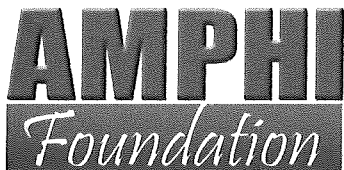

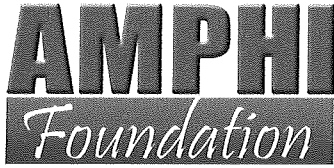

Provide an objective and the purpose of the project

General purpose of the project:

We would like to do 2 STEM field days for all our students at Rio Vista Elementary. The idea is that all teachers will plan 2 STEM activities to be shared with students at their grade level and below/above their grade level.

Describe the project and how it will enhance the learning environment and promote academic excellence.

List the subject areas involved in the project.

Project Synopsis:

K-1, 2-3, 4-5 students will rotate through a teacher at each coupled grade levels (Ex. Kinder students will engage in a kinder STEM lesson and another STEM lesson from a 1st grade teacher) . We designate 1 morning each semester to only teaching STEM in all classrooms. Each teacher will plan a total of 2 STEM lessons that will accommodate 60+ students. We have the specialist, interventionists, aids, etc helping in a classroom teaching the STEM lesson. There will be a cost for the teachers to purchase supplies for their STEM lesson. Therefore, this grant will purchase the needed supplies to keep our STEM Days a part of Rio Vista's instruction. Teachers will make a list of needed supplies and get the list of their supplies to the STEM Committee and the STEM committee will purchase needed supplies. We give each teacher a limit of \$25-\$30 for each lesson, for a total of \$50-\$60 per teacher. We had our first STEM Day last year, it was a huge success. This year we would like to have 2 STEM Days this year. All the activities were hands-on and engaging. The students particularly loved switching classes and going to another teacher's classroom for a STEM lesson. The teachers loved the activities and found that the students really had a great time. The teachers all said that the students were really engaged and they also liked switching up the student learning/activities.
