The Hidden Valley Girls Varsity Basketball Team is planning a trip to Hawaii to play in a Basketball Invitational Tournament December 26-29, 2018. There will be 10 players and 2 coaches traveling out of state. The girls basketball program and parents have fundraised and or will pay for their child's portion of the trip.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

In 2006 the Hidden Valley boys basketball team played in a tournament in Alaska. This year the coaches, players and parents have helped fundraised most of the money required for the trip. Parents are also financially responsible for a portion of the cost. Parents have been notified of this trip and a preliminary roster will be made May 30, 2018. 2018-2019 Varsity Lady Mustang Hawaii Trip

Trip To Hawaii = Date #1 choice = December 16th to December 23rd, 2018 or #2. choice
December 26th to January 2nd

Purpose of trip is to educate our student athletes about the state of Hawaii by teaching them about the ocean and the marine life, active volcanoes and the Hawaiian peoples cultures. We will also play 2-3 basketball game vs Hawaiian schools. We will provide fundraising opportunities for each family to help pay for this trip so families will have very little out of pocket expense, the kids who help fundraise will get credit to their account to help pay for it, we will not require more than \$500.00 each student athlete if they don't do their part in helping to fundraise for the trip. I would estimate that it will cost \$1,900 for each student. Below are the potential costs and potential itinerary.

- * Air plane tickets @ \$925 a person x 10 student athletes & 3 coaches = \$12,025
- * Accommodations @ \$4,500
- * Van rentals @ \$1,200
- * Food @ \$2,000
- * Activities @ \$1,800

Total Cost = \$21,525.00

Itinerary

Day 1 =- Travel from Medford/Portland to Kona Hawaii. Get to the island rent vans and get settled in rental House.

Day 2 = Let girls sleep in to recover from travelling, Fun and educational day , working out and practicing at a local gym at night, Watch game film and learn about Manta Rays & Krill and there environment and their purpose in the eco system. Also learn about Hawaiian islanders in how they made canoes and how they travelled.

Day #3 = Game Day with Kona Waina, after game Kona Waina will host a luau/dinner

Day #4 = Fun and educational day #2 with working out and practicing at local gym, Watch Game film & learn about Dolphins, sea turtles and fish

Day #5 = Game Day or Fun and educational day #3 working out, practicing in local gym, go to a reef and learn about the Oceans eco systems

Day #6 = travel to Hilo in morning and go to state park and see active volcano and play a team Wainakea

Day #7 = Recovery day relax on Beach from practice & games.

Day #8 = Travel back home
