District Goal or Objective Addressed:

Priority 4: Fiscal Management - Maximize student experiences through transparent, strategic, and sustainable fiscal management.

Background Information:

RFP #2605-475-424 for 2026 Fencing Improvements was published on May 14, 2026, to procure fencing and gate replacements at four campus locations. The project scope encompasses fence replacements at Lakewood Elementary, Leon Heights Elementary, and Tarver Elementary, and gate replacements and miscellaneous fencing repairs at the Delta Facility.

The District received responses from six (6) contractors by the deadline of June 1, 2026, which were evaluated and ranked by a committee. Based on the rankings, the Administration recommends awarding contracts as follows:

1. American Perimeters (von Rajcs Construction, LLC) for proposals submitted for Tarver Elementary and Delta Facility, for an amount not to exceed \$164,261.
2. The Anchor Group, Inc., for proposals submitted for Lakewood Elementary and Leon Heights Elementary, for an amount not to exceed \$166,462.

Pursuant to Section 2252.908 of Government Code, HB 1295 forms have been received and will be acknowledged on the Texas Ethics Commission website.

Fiscal Implications:

The projects will be funded from the 2022 Bond funds.
